Admission to the One Year Postgraduate Diploma Programme in Wellness and Spa Management

NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission to the One Year Postgraduate Diploma Programme in Wellness and Spa Management at Regional Centre, Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Ettumanoor for the academic year 2019-20. Eligibility for admission will be a pass in BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery) Degree from an institution recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicine and shall possess a permanent registration in the respective council/Board of the concerned state. Admission will be based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination, physical fitness, Group Discussion and interview. Number of seats for the Post Graduate Diploma programme shall be 5, out of which 2 seats are reserved for the outside state candidates. The maximum age for admission shall be 35 as on the date of Notification.

Candidates seeking admission to the Programme are directed to submit the online application through the University website www.ssus.ac.in/ www.ssusonline.org on or before 21.06.2019 Application fee of Rs.500/- (Rs.200/- for SC/ST Candidates) shall be remitted to the University account online or by way of Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit chalan receipt which can be remitted at any branch of Union Bank of India.

A print copy of the online application submitted with the copies of documents and fee receipt shall be sent to the Director, Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Regional Centre, Ettumanoor, Kerala on or before 26.06.2019.

2019 Admissions
PROSPECTUS

1. The Postgraduate Diploma programme in Wellness and Spa Management shall be offered at the University Regional Centre, Ettumanoor, Kottayam District.

2. Programme Structure

The Postgraduate Diploma programme in Wellness and Spa Management consists of 8 courses in wellness and Spa Management including project work and industrial project work of 40 credits in two semesters with a minimum of 915 working hours.

3. Programme duration

Two semesters within a period of one year. The 1st semester shall be from June to October and 2nd semester from December to April. The working days will be from Monday to Friday. There will be one month break in November between the semesters.

4. Eligibility for Admission

Candidates who have passed BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery) Degree from an institution recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicine and shall possess a permanent registration in the respective council/Board of the concerned state, are eligible for admission.

No Person shall be eligible for admission to the Post Graduate Diploma Programme if he/she is currently on the Rolls for any academic programme in any other subject/discipline offered in this University or in any other institution.

5. Age

The maximum age for admission shall be 35 as on the date of admission notification

6. Selection procedure

Selection shall be made on the basis of the marks of the qualifying examination, Group Discussion, Physical fitness and Interview. The maximum marks will be 100, of which 50 marks for the qualifying examination, 20 marks for Group Discussion, 10 marks for physical fitness and 20 marks for interview.

Group discussion and Interview shall be conducted by a committee consisting of Campus Director, Head of the department of Ayurveda and an external expert, nominated by the head of the department of Ayurveda.

Candidates who have secured 50% of the total marks shall be eligible for admission (45% for SC/ST candidates).

Every reasonable step shall be taken by the university to intimate the date, time and venue for group discussion, Physical Fitness and interview to the candidates. However the University shall not be responsible for the delay in the receipt of the intimation for interview by the candidates.

Physical fitness parameters are height, weight, blood pressure and lung capacity. Any degree / form of differently abled shall not be considered

Interview and group discussion will focus on Wellness, Management skills, grooming standards, proficiency in English, communication skills, soft skills, service orientation and hospitality.

The students admitted to the Postgraduate Diploma programme shall abide by the laws of the University as amended from time to time.

7. Number of seats

Number of seats for the Post Graduate Diploma programme shall be 5, out of which 2 seats are reserved for the outside state candidates. In the absence of eligible outside state candidates, the same shall be filled up by the eligible candidates from Kerala. Outside state candidates shall produce proof of residence/nativity/domicile certificate from the competent authority along with the application.

Reservation of seats will be as per the Govt. /University rules.

Separate ranked lists shall be drawn up for reserved seats as per the existing rules

8. Medium and mode of Instruction

Medium of instruction shall be English/Sanskrit and the teaching and training pedagogy include lectures, seminars, practicals, demonstrations, discussions, presentations, study tour, wellness industry visit, Project work and Industrial project work.

9. Documents to be produced in original at the time of Group Discussion and Interview

- Secondary School Leaving Certificate (S.S.L.C)
- Mark list/Grade sheet of qualifying examination
- . Degree Certificate
- . Migration Certificate
- Transfer Certificate and Conduct certificate from the institution last attended.
- Community certificate (if eligible for community reservation).
- Permanent Medical Council Registration
- Two recent passport size photographs

All certificates and mark lists including S.S.L.C Book should be submitted at the office at the time of admission. The certificates and the mark lists thus submitted will not be returned until the student leaves the university or till the completion of the course. The student may take sufficient number of Photostat copies of these documents, get them attested and keep with him/her for use before the admission.

10. Fees structure (in Rupees)

- In addition to the above, students have to pay the PTA Fund

Fees for the Postgraduate Diploma programme shall be remitted fully at the time of admission, failing which the claim for admission will be forfeited. The fees, other than caution deposit, once remitted shall not be refunded. The caution deposit will be refunded only after the students clear all the dues outstanding against him. Decision of the Heads of the Departments / Campus Director with regard to the dues outstanding shall be final and binding upon the student/ students concerned.

11. HOW TO APPLY

Candidate seeking admission for Postgraduate Diploma programme shall submit online application through the University Website www.ssus.ac.in or www.ssusonline.org on or before the last date prescribed ie. 21.06.2019.

The print copy of the online application shall be sent to the Campus Director, SreeSankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Regional Centre, Ettumanoor along with the copies of documents and original Fee receipt.

Application Fee shall be remitted to the University account online or by way of Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit chalan receipt which can be remitted at any branch of Union Bank of India. The print copy of online application along with the copies of documents and original Fee receipt shall be sent to the Campus Director, SreeSankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Regional Centre, Ettumanoor on or before the last date.
